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### Note on visiting

Only three of the buildings illustrated in this book are open to the public – Marker's Cottage, Broadclyst, Devon, and Hardy's Cottage, Higher Bockhampton, Dorset, which belong to the National Trust, and the reconstructed *clom* cottage at the Museum of Welsh Life. All the others are privately owned. As internal surfaces are plastered there is rarely anything to see of the construction inside.
